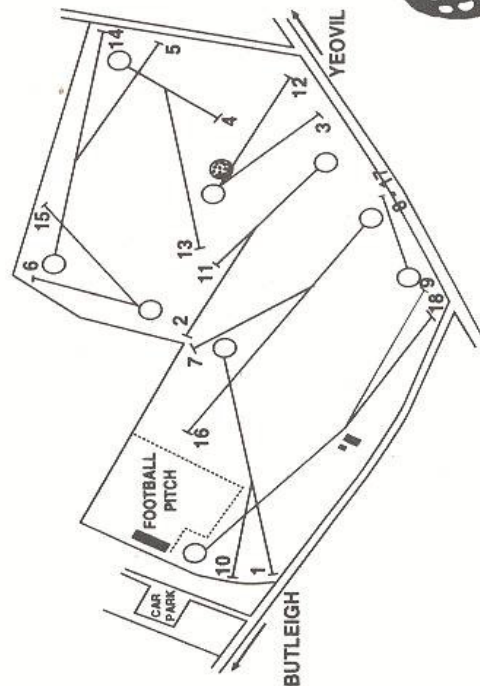


1. **OUT OF BOUNDS** (Rule 27) The area outside all perimeter hedges and fencing. In the case of post and wire fencing, a line should be taken from the inside line of the two nearest posts.
2. **WATER HAZARD** (Rule 26.1) The area within that marked by yellow posts in front of the 3rd / 12th greens
3. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** (Rule 24.2) All goal posts, netting, corner flags, staked trees, horse pens, portable buildings, plant, litter bins, taps and hose pipes. The ball shall be lifted and dropped, without penalty, within one club's length on a point a) not nearer the hole b) not in a hazard or on the putting green.
4. **BALL STRIKING IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS**  
If a ball strikes an immovable obstruction it shall be played as it lies but can be moved as specified in Rule 3.
5. **INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE** All buildings, huts, hard standing areas, trees and tree stumps are integral parts of the course. If a ball is unplayable, rule 28 applies.
6. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR**  
Main football pitch, cricket pitches, line markings and vehicle tracks must be treated as ground under repair, you must lift the ball and drop, without penalty, one club length from the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole.
7. **WINTER RULES** Winter rules will apply at all times unless advertised otherwise on the notice board. A ball may be lifted and placed within 6" not nearer the hole, if it is lying on closely mown grass.
8. Do not play the 11<sup>th</sup> tee until the 13<sup>th</sup> tee is clear. Do not play the 16<sup>th</sup> tee until 1st / 10th green is clear.

#### COURSE ETIQUETTE

1. Millfield School Games and Kingweston Golf Club matches and competitions take priority on the Course.
2. - Single Players must give way to all other players.  
- Two-ball matches have priority over all other matches.
3. Do not start on the first tee if a match is about to play the 10th hole.
4. Slow Play. In particular please note:-
  - a) If you lose more than one clear hole on the match ahead you must invite the following match to pass.
  - b) A player does not have five minutes to look for a lost ball. Immediately you are holding up a following match you must call them through.  
(Search should be abandoned after five minutes - see Rule 27).
5. Repair pitch marks on the Greens. Rake bunkers.
