Please ask your guest to produce this when approached by staff or stewards. The new system has been put in place for the benefit of all players and therefore we ask that you make full use of it to ensure a more secure and user friendly course.**



## Security

The security fence access code has been changed as from September 2009. You should have received notification, if not; please ring and we will forward new details on to you. The code will be changing on a regular basis throughout 2010. The car park is located to the side of the pavilion controlled by a sliding mechanical gate. We would still strongly advise all golfers to ensure that NO valuables or bags are left on display in your vehicle.
