1. Membership discs must be displayed at all times and shown to Ground Staff and Stewards upon request. Millfield reserves the right to ask any person(s) not in possession of a disc to leave the course.
2. Members may bring a guest to play at Kingweston Golf Course – a £6 green fee is charged. Guests must use the new ticketing machine on entry to the course. Once paid, a ticket will be provided as proof of payment. Please ask your guest to produce this when approached by the staff or stewards.
3. No unauthorised players may use the course.
4. Millfield cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage of personal property or injury to players on Kingweston Golf Course.
5. Millfield reserves the right to close Kingweston Golf Course when school sports fixtures are played and will attempt to give advanced notice to minimise inconvenience to course members.
6. Reasonable behaviour and adherence to normal course etiquette should be demonstrated at all times.
7. A one off joining fee is required for all new members to Kingweston Golf Society, however, failure to renew membership annually will result in an administration fee being levied. Current fee charges can be obtained from Millfield Enterprises Office.
