

## **Millfield English Language Holiday Courses (MELHC) Provision for Pupils with particular religious, dietary, language or cultural needs**

MELHC is committed to ensuring equality and celebrating diversity in the life of its students throughout all aspects of their education and will make all reasonable provision for pupils with particular religious, dietary, language or cultural needs.

The need for such provision should be identified prior to joining the school in discussion with the Enterprises team. This information will then be given to the Houseparent and Pastoral Manager. The Houseparent will ensure that appropriate staff are informed. Parents/Guardians/Agents/Group Leaders should inform the Houseparent if they have a child at MELHC who has changed requirements.

Where appropriate, information about such needs will be recorded on medical lists.

In consultation with the Pastoral Manager, Chartwells (Millfield's catering provider) supply a range of food to suit most needs. The Houseparent will liaise with Chartwells about pupils with particular dietary needs.

MELHC is committed to nurturing a multi-faith community. The Centre Manager and MELHC Manager will ensure there is provision for all the major Christian denominations and other religions.
